	Lack of Railing or Unstable Railing Add railing to one side of stairway or if current railing is unstable, repair it.	Notes		
	Uneven Steps and/or Pavement Have steps and/or pavement repaired.			
	Lack of Lighting Add outdoor light fixture.	·

	Uneven or Slippery Floor Make sure floor is dry at all times, add rug to slippery wood flooring, consider adding grab bar next to door for added stability.	Notes		
	Cluttered Area Organize and remove problematic items.			
	Dark or Poor Lighting Add additional lights or increase wattage.			
	Limited Access to Ceiling Light Add extenders to ceiling light switches or add wall lighting.

	Poor Lighting Add additional lights or increase wattage.	Notes		
	Cluttered Area Eliminate clutter on floors by organizing and removing problematic items.			
	Electric Cords Across Floor Run cords behind furniture; arrange items so they can be plugged in closer to outlets.			
	Presence of Challenging Furniture Add assistive equipment to help get in and out of difficult seating areas.			
	Inaccessible Light Switches Access light fixtures with assistive products.

	Cluttered Area Eliminate clutter by organizing and removing problematic items.	Notes		
	Electric Cords Across Floor Run cords behind furniture or arrange items so appliances can be easily plugged in.			
	Bed Mobility Use assistive device to allow easy, stable access in and out of bed.			
	Poor Lighting Add additional lights or increase wattage.			
	Poor Room Arrangement Use assistive device to allow you to easily reach items.

	Presence of Unsecured Bath Rug Use bath rug with non-slip bottom.	Notes		
	Lack of Support in Tub Add grab bars to tub and around bathroom where appropriate.			
	Lack of Support Near Toilet Add grab bars on sides of toilet and around bathroom where appropriate.			
	Low Toilet Add raised toilet seat for added height.			
	Slippery Tub Add a rubber bath mat or safety treads.			
	Lack of Bathroom Support Add a bath chair along with hand-held shower and grab bars where needed.
